# SCHOOL TAX COLLECTION FOR 2021-22 SCHOOL YEAR


The district has subscribed to Tax Collection services at Tompkins-Seneca-Tioga (TST) BOCES since July 2021.

All 2021-22 school tax bills will be mailed directly to taxpayers' mailing address on file with county real property offices. Taxpayers who have an escrow account with a mortgage company or bank will receive their tax bills for informational purposes only. Mortgage companies and banks will receive tax information directly from the Tax Collector. No actions need to be taken by taxpayers who have escrow accounts.

Taxpayers who own multiple properties in the district will receive a tax bill for each property separately since bills are no longer sorted manually by mailing address.

Mail in payments are no longer accepted at the JP Morgan Chase lock box. Taxpayers should follow instructions on the tax bills for payment information. You may also make payments at Community Bank located at 7193 Main St., Ovid, NY. All school tax related questions should be directed to the Tax Collector at:

in the snow belt, they moved to Trumansburg and bought Holton's Pharmacy, now Kinney. Milli handled bookkeeping and the gift section, and generally kept things running on track. She loved to travel. Milli was one of thousands of direct descendants of John Robinson, pastor of the Pilgrims.

Taxpayers can request a receipt by checking the "Check for receipt" box on the payment stub. If requested, receipts will be mailed to taxpayers within a month after payment is received. Taxpayers can view updated payment status on www.tax-lookup.net once payment is posted to the taxpayer's account, which usually happens within 4 days of receipt of check payment.

New this year is the "E-check" payment option. Taxpayers can input checking account information and make a payment through www.taxlookup.net. A service fee of \$1.50 will be charged. However, payment will be posted to the account immediately and taxpayers can print out a receipt for their records in real time.

Please note, the credit card service fee is displayed on taxlookup.net. Once the "Continue to Payment" button is clicked, the MuniciPay website will appear. Click the "Pay with E-Check" tab on the right side of the screen, and the service fee will change to \$1.50.

Please note the collection period for the 2021-22 school year will be over a 2 month period instead of a 3 month period. The penalty free period is September 1, 2021 to October 1, 2021, and the 2% penalty period is October 2, 2021 to November 1, 2021. Any payments postmarked after November 1, 2021 will be returned to the taxpayer and their taxes will be assessed, with penalties, to their Town taxes.

Tax bills and receipts since 2011 school year can be found on line at www.taxlookup.net. 2021-22 school tax bills will be available on line on September 1, 2021.



PETS / LIVESTOCK PETS / LIVESTOCK DOGS: A STUDY IN(H

#### WE ARE NOT ACCEPTING NEW CLIENTS OR ADMITTING FORMER CLIENTS WHO HAVE NOT BEEN IN TO THE PRACTICE IN THE LAST THREE YEARS.

During office hours, visitors to my clinic can usually be assure of seeing two things. The first is that I will scurrying around in what appears to be a constant state of chaos, especially around the one o'clock and five o'clock hours. Secondly, a client can be fairly sure of seeing on the left rear corner of my the desk a large, often disheveled, stack of what look like magazines.These are, however, mostly peer-reviewed, continuing education, and medical science journals. They sit there to constantly re-mind me (whenever I get a free moment) to read them. Besides attending required continuing education classes, professional seminars, and consulting with colleagues, reading these magazines are how we vets keep up-to-date with the HUGE flow of new information that needs to be put into our already over-crowded brains.

As I said, most of them are peer reviewed, thick with scientific and medical studies, and are not light reading. One journal in the pile, however, provides a little relief from the drudgery: it's called DVM Magazine. The magazine is kind of like the National Enquirer of veterinary journals. In it are interesting columnists, whiney stories of how hard it is to go to vet school or to be in private practice, and of how our human counterparts make so much more money than us vets. I usually just skim the first few pages. But because it is moderately readable, it is one of Theresa's favorite magazines. And it was she who brought to my attention the following study.

A group in Colorado called The Coalition For Living States, which Dogs (www.livingsafelywithdogs. org/) did a study of why dogs bite and, most interesting to me, which dogs bite the most. Although it limited its study to dogs in Colorado, I think it pretty much states what I've always felt to be pretty close to the way it is. There were a couple of surprises. It must be stated before I begin that any dog for any reason can bite. It's just a fact of dog ownership. However, regular visitors to my practice know that there are three breeds of dogs that I am particularly cautious of: dachshunds, Dalmatians, and chow chows. I need to be very clear on this. I love dachshunds. My beloved clients who own dachshunds know I love dachshunds. Some of my best patients are dachshunds. But the worst bites five that I recall - I've ever gotten have been from dachshunds. My only problem with Dalmatians is that if there is gonna be a dog who has bitten a child badly (mutilate is a better word), most often will be a Dalmatian. And with regards to chows, owners who bring this breed into my office know how I feel. I tell them that I've almost had my left arm ripped-off by a rottweiler; I've been backed into the corner of my exam room and almost had my nose chewed-off by a German shepherd; and I've had to sew my left pointing finger back together from a bite by an American Eskimo; but these breeds you sort of expect to be often nasty. Chows, however, are just plain sinister. They're sneekie. They lull you into a false sense of comfort with their cute little beady eyes, and then they pounce at you like they literally want to kill you! There are a couple of exceptional chows (and my treasured clients who own them know who they are) but they are few and far between. I can hear it out there now: And so Doc, what about the usually profiled vicious breeds like German shepherds, Dobermans, and pitbulls?" My answer is, again, yes, these guys can be quite vicious, but you sort of expect it from these guys. Theresa and I love German Shepherds. Our last two personal dogs were shepherds. And with regards to dobies and pitbulls, I've never met a single one who I haven't liked. Sure, there are stories all the time about these breeds killing or mutilating people, but so have Labradors, golden retrievers, and Chihuahuas! So much for what I think. The Colorado study (which is fifty-five pages long and can be down-loaded from the web page mentioned above) has the following conclusions: 1.) Chihuahuas are the most likely dog to bite a veterinarian (I'm not too sure about this one.) Again, as it pertains to veterinarians, Lhaso Apsos delivered the most severe bites.
 Of the 188 breeds in the study, the top five involved in biting were: Labrador retrievers (somewhat of a surprise to me), pit bulls, German shepherds, Rottweillers, and chow-chows (no surprise here!) 4.) The top five for bites involving children: Labradors, pit bulls, German shepherds, smooth-coated Chihuahuas, and Rottweillers. 5.) And finally, with some much-welcomed vindication for all of the verbal abuse I've taken from owners over the years, the top five dogs for being the bearers of the worst injuries from biting: American Bulldogs (there aren't a lot of these guys around), Dalmatians!!!!!!! (not a bit of surprise here!), standard dachshunds!!!!!! (but I still love these little guys), English bulldogs (somewhat of a surprise to me), and Lhaso apsos. Thanks again.
