MUSHERS, A DOG NAMED BALTO, AND THE LAST GREAT RACE ON EARTH: THE 2024 IDITAROD

(Reprinted from 2024) The world-famous Iditarod is an epic sled dog race that captures the spirit of adventure, endurance, and the indomitable bond between humans and their canine companions every year. This grueling event takes place in the rugged wilderness of Alaska, covering just over 1000 miles in distance between the city of Anchorage and the village of Nome. It pits man and woman and their dogs against raw mother nature in all of her splendid majesty and brutal, unforgiving fury; it is considered by many to be truly "The Last Great Race on Earth."

Although the Iditarod Trail had been used by Native American peoples for hundreds of years before the arrival of Russian settlers in the 1800s, the present-day race actually commemorates a relatively recent event. In early 1925, a deadly diphtheria outbreak occurred in the northern Bering Sea coastal city of Nome. On February 2nd of that year, a musher named Gunnar Kaasen and his team of huskies, guided by his lead dog, Balto, became the first of several lifesaving missions to deliver diphtheria antitoxin to the disease-stricken city. (As a point of interest, in Central Park in the great city of New York, there is a bronze statue of Balto inscribed as follows (from Wikipedia): "Dedicated to the indomitable spirit of the sled dogs that relayed antitoxin six hundred miles over rough ice, across treacherous waters, through Arctic blizzards from Nenana to the relief of a stricken Nome in the winter of 1925. Endurance—fidelity—intelligence.")

The first official Iditarod Trail Race was run in 1973. Prior to this, sled dog racing had a long and popular history within the state. One of the more popular of these races was called the All-Alaska Sweepstakes. It was at this event in 1910 that saw the introduction of the first Siberian husky dog to Alaska. Before this, the primary breed used was the Alaskan malamute. This year's race had 29 teams of 12 - 16 dogs and their sled driver (called mushers.) The trail is divided into 24 checkpoints, and the race is usually completed in 9 to 12 days. The winner was Dallas Seavey of Talkeetna, Alaska. His race time was 9 days, 2 hours, 16 minutes, and 8 seconds. The 2024 race was Mr. Seavey's record-setting sixth win. In 2017, Seavey also accomplished the fastest time for completing the race. That time was 8 days, 3 hours, 40 minutes, and 13 seconds, set in 2017. This year's race, sadly, was marred by the death of 3 dogs. Also, Mr. Seavey and his dogs were attacked by a moose. The musher had to shoot the moose, but not before the animal seriously wounded one of the Huskies. Although he required two surgeries, the dog did live.


The word "Huskie" takes its name from the derogatory term "Eskie," which refers to all Native Eskimo peoples living all over the Arctic. The word "Siberian" refers to the land of Siberia, presently Northeastern Russia. Some archeologists believe that the predecessors of the modern Siberian husky breed helped the early settlers of our continent cross the land bridge formed between North America and Asia during the last ice age.

Finally, and this is something I had to look up on Wikipedia, the term mushing refers to any form of transport powered by dogs. It is believed that the term has its origin in the French word "marche," which means to go or to run. A person who directs this form of transport is a "musher."

Facility Description: Applicant applied to the New York State Office of Renewable Energy Siting and Electric Transmission (Office or ORES) for a permit pursuant to Public Service Law article VIII to construct and operate a 90-megawatt (MW) solar energy facility located in the Towns of Waterloo and Junius, Seneca County.

Applicant filed the application with the Office on March 4, 2024. A notice of complete application was issued on January 13, 2025. To access the notice, go to <https://dps.ny.gov/ores-permit-applications>, and click on Project Permit Application Number 23-02974.

ORES staff published draft permit conditions on March 13, 2025. To access the draft permit conditions, go to <https://dps.ny.gov/ores-permit-applications> and click on Project Permit Application Number 23-02974.

ORES Staff Position: On issuing the draft permit conditions, ORES staff takes the position that the proposed facility, together with the uniform and site-specific standards and conditions contained in the draft permit, would comply with applicable laws and regulations. ORES staff recommends that the Office elect not to apply, in whole or in part, any local law or ordinance that as applied to the facility is unreasonably burdensome in view of the Climate Leadership and Community Protection Act targets and the environmental benefits of the proposed facility.

Public Comment Hearing: A public comment hearing pursuant to 16 NYCRR part 1100 to hear and receive unsworn comments from the public will be held at the **Waterloo Community Center, 3 Oak Street, Waterloo, NY 13165 on Wednesday, May 14, 2025, at 6:00 p.m.**

All persons, organizations, corporations, or government agencies who may be affected by the facility are invited to attend the hearing and comment on the application and the draft permit conditions. Lengthy comments will not be accepted and instead should be submitted in writing. Equal weight will be given to both oral and written comments. To ensure that all interested persons have an opportunity to speak, the Administrative Law Judges (ALJs) may limit the time available for oral comments to three (3) minutes per person. The public comment hearing will be transcribed for inclusion in the administrative record.

The hearing location is reasonably accessible to persons with a mobility impairment. Interpreter services shall be made available to deaf persons, and English language translator services shall also be made available, at no charge for either service, upon written request to Chief ALJ James T. McClymonds, Office of Renewable Energy Siting and Electric Transmission, Empire State Plaza, P-1 South, J Dock, Albany, NY 12242, (518) 473-4590, ores.hearings@dps.ny.gov. All requests must be received no later than 4:00 p.m. on Wednesday, April 30, 2025.

In the event that the in-person public comment hearing needs to be canceled, rescheduled, postponed, or conducted virtually, notification of any change will be available at the ORES website at <https://dps.ny.gov/ores>.

Written Public Comments: Written comments concerning the application and the draft permit conditions must be filed with ORES by **5:00 p.m. on Friday, May 16, 2025**. Persons filing written comments are strongly encouraged to post their comments on the Department of Public Service (DPS) Document and Matter Management (DMM) system. To post a comment, go to <https://dps.ny.gov/ores>, click on "ORES Permit Applications," click on Project Permit Application Number 23-02974, and click on "Post Comments" in the upper right-hand corner of the screen.

Written comments may also be emailed to ORES at ores.hearings@dps.ny.gov or mailed to the Office of Renewable Energy Siting and Electric Transmission, Empire State Plaza, P-1 South, J Dock, Albany, NY 12242. Written comments will be considered equally with oral statements delivered at the public comment hearing, provided they are postmarked by **Friday, May 16, 2025**, or e-mailed or posted on DMM by 5:00 p.m. on that date.

Please take notice that written public comments will be publicly posted on DMM. ORES reserves the right not to post duplicate or repeat comments. In addition, ORES reserves the right to remove, without notice, comments containing any defamatory, infringing, obscene, indecent, discriminatory, confidential, or unlawful material or information of any kind.

Issues Determination Procedure: Pursuant to 16 NYCRR 1100-8.3(b), a pre-adjudicatory issues determination procedure will be conducted by the assigned ALJs. The procedure will be conducted solely on papers and briefing unless the ALJs, in the judges' sole discretion, determine that oral argument is necessary. The purpose of the issues conference is to determine party status for any person or organization that has properly filed a petition (as indicated below), and to narrow and define those issues, if any, that will require adjudication in this matter. Participation in the issues determination

procedure is limited to ORES staff, applicant, and those persons or organizations requesting party status.

Filing for Party Status and Proposed Issues: Persons seeking to participate in the issues determination procedure and any subsequent adjudicatory hearing must register on DMM and file a written petition explaining whether their request is for full party status or amicus status. For the required contents of petitions for full party status, see 16 NYCRR 1100-8.4(c)(1) and (2). To determine whether an issue is substantive and significant, see 16 NYCRR 1100-8.3(c)(2) and (3). For the required contents of a petition seeking amicus status, see 16 NYCRR 1100-8.4(c)(1) and (3). Petitioners may also file written briefs making arguments in support of their petitions.

All petitions requesting party status and briefs in support must be E-Filed on DMM no later than **4:00 p.m. on Monday, May 19, 2025**. Instructions for registering in DMM and E-Filing documents may be found at: <https://dps.ny.gov/dmm-help-electronic-filing-registration-instructions>.

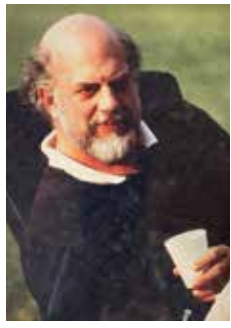

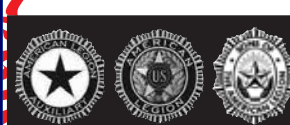
